- All medications (with the exception of Epi-Pens and/or rescue inhalers) will be collected at drop-off
 on Monday morning. If your child is riding the bus to camp, their medication will be collected by a
 counselor upon boarding the bus; if you are dropping off your camper at the Taconic Outdoor
 Education Center, their medication will be collected by our Health Supervisor.
- Please store your camper's medication(s) in a Ziploc bag with their name clearly printed on the
 front. All medications should remain in their original container with the camper's name and dosage
 information clearly printed.
